

RATE NOTICE



Harris-Montgomery Counties MUD 386 (the District) is one of many Districts that lie within the boundaries of the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA) and are billed by the NHCRWA for groundwater pumpage. The District passes this fee onto customers which is displayed on your water bill as “NHCRWA Fee.”

EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2019, THIS MANDATORY FEE WILL INCREASE from \$3.50 per 1,000 Gallons to \$3.97 per 1,000 Gallons of water used.

which includes 3% to cover water loss and water quality flushing.

The NHCRWA was created to develop and implement a strategy for complying with the Harris-Galveston Subsidence District’s Regulatory Plan that requires the reduction of groundwater usage to no more than 20% of the total water demand by 2030. Since the Authority is not a taxing entity, funding for future water supply and the infrastructure through which to deliver it is being accomplished through the sale of revenue bonds, and paid for by groundwater pumpage fees. Defined Irrigation Schedule and Water Use Policy

Harris-Montgomery Counties Municipal Utility District No. 386 (the “District”) has adopted a **Defined Irrigation Schedule and Water Use Policy** effective June 1, 2017 for the Harris County portion of the District. This policy is intended to reduce irrigation during certain times of the day to reduce “peak” usage while providing customers with adequate water for landscaping. Residential irrigation is recommended only three days per week while Non-Residential (Commercial/HOA) irrigation is limited to two days per week.

50% Commercial (Section B): Thursday
